

## **GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION**

### **Oral:**

1. Last date for Abstract submission is January 30-2012.
2. Abstracts may be submitted on any topic pertaining to clinical, epidemiological, diagnostic, therapeutic, and preventive aspects of infectious diseases in pediatric or adult medicine.
3. Abstracts must be sent through Email as an attachment.
4. Fax or hard copy will not be accepted.
5. Abstracts must contain original material.
6. Single case report will not be accepted.
7. Case series can be submitted.
8. Format should included Title, Name of Author(s), Institution, Telephone, Email.
9. Please structure your abstract using the following headings: Objective, Methods, Results, and Conclusion.
10. Abstracts written in substandard or vague language promising 'further discussion' will not be accepted.
11. Abstracts must not be longer than 250 words.
12. All abstracts will be peer reviewed before acceptance.
13. Oral presentation must be made by the senior author.
14. Abstracts must be accompanied with completed Registration Form and appropriate Registration Fee.
15. You will be notified of acceptance or otherwise by February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012.
16. Please note that you may submit the article pertaining to your abstract to the Editor, Infectious Diseases Journal of Pakistan at [pak\\_idj@yahoo.com](mailto:pak_idj@yahoo.com) for publication in the special issue of the Journal. This Journal is recognized by HEC, EMRO, PMDC, CPSP, WHO.

### **Poster:**

1. Abstracts must be sent through Email. Fax or hard copy will not be accepted.
2. Abstracts must contain original material.
3. Each presenter will be allocated a display board measuring 4 feet high and 3 feet wide.
4. Posters should be visible from a distance of 1 meter; therefore alphabets 4 cms high should be used for the title. Use of colors is recommended.
5. The poster should be organized in sections: Introduction, Methods, Results and Conclusions.
6. Senior author or trainee must be present during poster sessions.
7. Abstracts for the poster must be accompanied with completed Registration Form and appropriate Registration Fee.
8. Last date for Abstracts submission for posters is January 30, 2012.
9. Three best posters will be judged for prizes.
10. You may submit the article pertaining to your poster presentation to the Editor, Infectious Diseases Journal of Pakistan at [pak\\_idj@yahoo.com](mailto:pak_idj@yahoo.com) for publication in the special issue of the Journal. This Journal is recognized by HEC, EMRO, PMDC, CPSP, WHO.
